**1 JR Koboro Station**

The train station is located in an 80m wide valley between two railway tunnels. Off the beaten track, this station lures a lot of railway lovers. As only a couple of local trains stop a day, please make sure to double-check the train timetable on the JR Hokkaido website. Otherwise, you might be left out of the way.

**2 Suisha**

With a calm and relaxed atmosphere, a shop space has a fine selection of craftsworks by local artists and processed food products. Also, a cafe serves seasonal dishes made of local marine and farm produce in Toyoura. Try curry and rice with plenty of scallop meat.

**3 Spa Shiosai**

Soak the day's fatigue with 100% natural spring water and relax with the view of Volcano Bay. The facilities accommodate a restaurant and inn, accepting both overnight stay tourists and bathers who visit while sightseeing trip.

**4 Michi-no-Eki Toyoura**

The farmers' market sells fresh local vegetables, seafood and processed food products. Toyoura's specialties, strawberry is in the high season in June, while scallop is on sale alive in wintertime. Popular takeaways include strawberry-taste soft-serve ice cream and skewer of three pieces of fried scallop meat, called "Scallop Flyweight".

**5 Irie-Takasago Shell Mound Center**

Approximately 200 exhibits of relics excavated mainly from Irie-Takasago. Many exhibits including accessories made of tooth of wild pig living in Honshu, fishing tools made of deer and ceramics. Can be visited together with the Irie-Takasago Shell Mound Park, which is just a five minute walk away.

**6 Michi-no-Eki Aputa**

The farmers' market sells fresh local vegetables, seafood and processed food products with producers' name tags. You can eat scallop food menus and a rice bowl with sea urchin while enjoying the vista of a panoramic Volcano Bay.

**7 Usu Zenkoji Museum**

The Usu Zenkoji Museum is adjacent to Usu Zenkoji Temple, and holds on display over 200 valuable items, such as statues of the Shaka-Nyorai Buddha and Enku which have been designated as Hokkaido cultural assets. It tells the complete history of Usu Zenkoji Temple.

The local museum boasts exhibits concerning Japan's ancient Jomon, Ainu, and warriors' cultures, including cultural properties and artworks with a close relation to Date city. It is annexed with crafting facilities that provide hands-on dyeing and sword making observation opportunities.

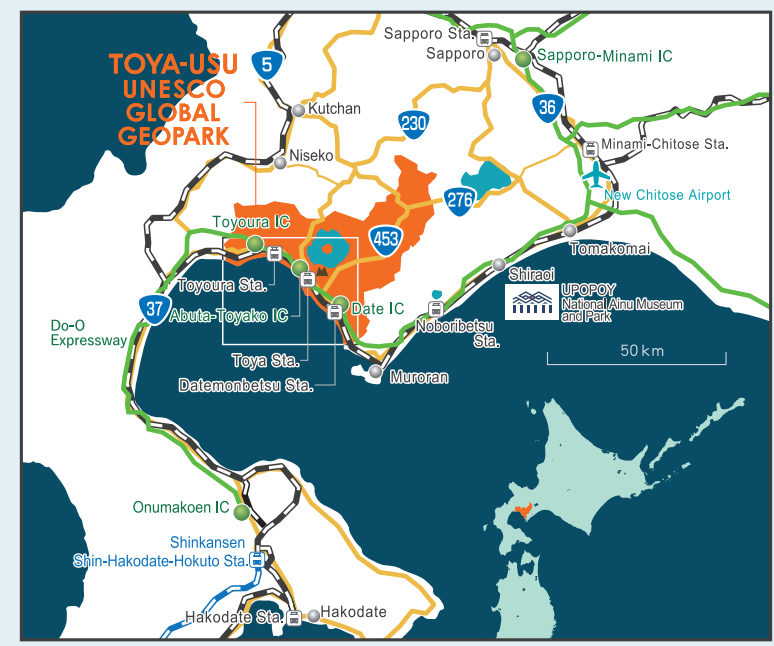
**9 Michi-no-Eki Date Rekishi-no-Mori**

Combined with a restroom and information centre, the farmers' market provides a good selection of local products. About 80 local farmers deliver fresh vegetables, while other producers bring processed seafood, livestock products and sweets on the market.

**10 Kitakogane Shell Mound Information Center**

The indoor facilities are located at the Kitakogane site, where shell mounds and graves have been reproduced. The exhibits of excavated materials and photo panels inspire visitors to learn about ancient Jomon times in the area. Hands-on programmes are available on a booking basis: Why not make comma-shaped beads or something?

~When you are on the promenade routes or hiking trails~

- For ensuring a safe and comfortable stay
  - Prepare your own water and hats, and make sure you traverse the trails in suitable clothing.
  - Safety is your responsibility. Please make sure you take care to enjoy walking on the trail.
  - Only smoke in designated areas.
  - Some courses are closed during the winter.
- For sustaining invaluable geological features, natural beauty and local culture for future generations
  - Do not litter: take your trash home with you.
  - Do not stray from wooden walkways or paths.
  - Do not set up camps or start fires outside of the designated areas.
  - Do not surprise or give food to any wild animals you come across.
  - Do not collect any of the plants or animals. Do not take any minerals. (Some areas are protected by law.)
